participants overall the findings show that small group work in language classrooms between students who do not share a common L1 provides students with opportunities to use communication strategies to negotiate meaning in an attempt to achieve a mutually comprehensible message the following are appended 1 a taxonomy used to identify communication strategies for this study taken from Dornyei and Scott 1995 and 2 data for students who were observed to speak 50 or more words contains 4 tables
